
STAIR DETAILS HOUGHTON COUNTY BUILDING DEPARTMENT 2015 RESIDENTIAL BUILDING CODE

Sections R311.7



- 1. Must determine floor covering (final) elevation to achieve accurate stair riser uniformity. The code, for safety (liability) reasons, allows only 3/8 of an inch difference in any tread or riser in the whole run. The maximum height of a step is 8 1/4 inches, no more. The minimum depth is 9 inches.
- 2. Railing/guard height is 36 inches, no less. Spacing between guard spindles no more than 4 inches. Open sides of steps need railing guard system with a minimum height of 34 inches and spindles spaced a maximum of 4 3/8".
- 3. Handrails are required on one side of all stairs with four or more risers. Minimum height of 34 inches and a maximum height of 38 inches.
- 4. Minimum headroom for any stairwell is 6 feet, 8 inches. This is measured vertically from sloped line adjoining the tread nosings.
- 5. Minimum width of any stairwell is 36 inches (to finished surfaces).
- 6. Minimum landing is 36" in depth.
- 7. All stairways require illumination.
- 8. STRENGTH: Must be able to sustain a single concentrated load of 200 pounds in any direction along the top of guard or handrail. Also, guard fill-in components (such as spindles) must withstand a 50 pound load on an area of one square foot.
