Shall the Village of Lake Linden continue to levy a total of 1.75 mills (\$1.75 per \$1,000.00), subject to applicable Headlee millage rollbacks, on taxable value of property located in the Village of Lake Linden for an additional 5 (five) years, beginning with the 2025 tax levy year and running through 2029 tax levy year (inclusive), which will raise an estimated revenue of \$30,975.00 in 2025, to be used for the purchase and upgrading of heavy equipment? If approved, this would be a renewal of a previously authorized millage.
