VI. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Houghton County Building Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

VII. Mobile Home unit

ITEM #17, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites. When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When setting a HUD mobile home or premanufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

VIII. PLAN REVIEW REQUIRED

Plans must be submitted with this application and the appropriate fee before a permit can be issued, except as listed below:
Plans are not required for the following:

1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area.
2. Work completed by a Governmental Subdivision or State Agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

Plans which are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear the architect's or engineer's signature and seal.

IX. APPLICANT / HOME OWNER SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, as amended by 1999 PA 245, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential structure.
